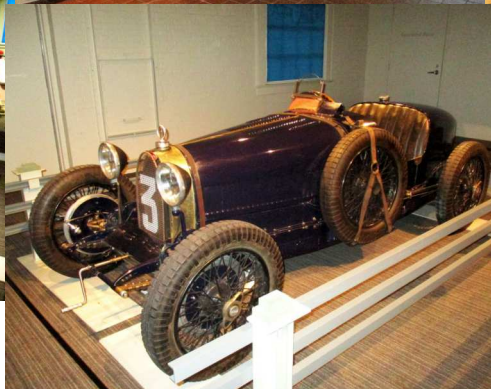
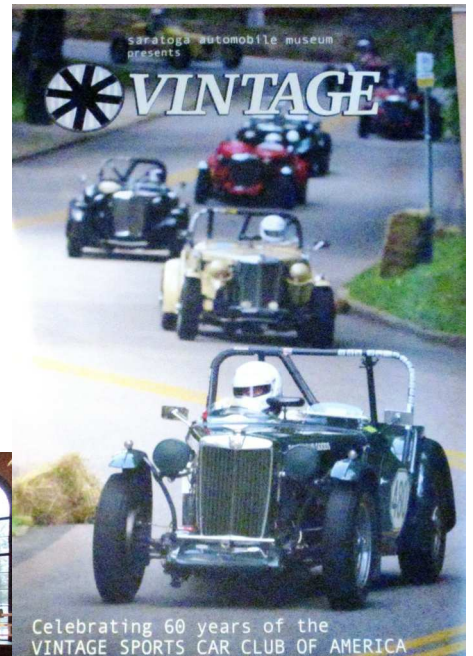
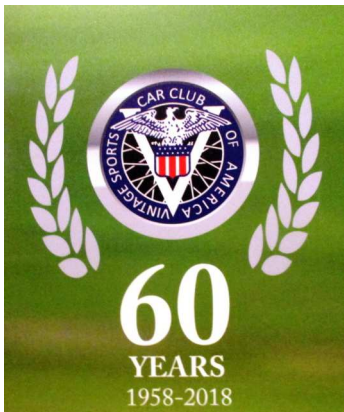
Saratoga Auto Museum in Saratoga Springs, has a very nice display commemorating 60 years of the VSCCA.

Michael called us a couple of weeks ago. He did most of the talking, mentioned again when the MG Car Club came down and filled his barn with cars. He was a man of emotions, secrets and dreams, aren't we all?

He really said that was a dream come true to see his new barn full of cars. A few more cars could maybe fill in around the edges. Remember that was quite the barn, it was huge! Over in the far corner a big rug on the floor, a large, comfy davenport and lounge chair, lamps on end tables and a small refrigerator for drinks and goodies. Also, a big crystal chandelier on the ceiling. I asked him why the chandelier? He said "why not?" with a twinkle in his eye. I said "why not?" too. I just wished I had thought of it when we made our garage into a party room. In another corner he had two lifts, an MGB up on one of them and another ready for another car. The main corner of the barn was full of tools and machines to work on cars. In the middle of the barn were several tables full of treats and drinks that Michael had furnished for us all to enjoy.

Michael was a man of many interests and hobbies. He went from one to the next like chapters in a book. His latest was building the huge barn and wanting to fill it with cars. Inviting the MG Car Club down to visit was his first view of his barn full of cars. There were about 25 cars that went down that day and we all parked inside the barn.

When Michael called that night, he said he wanted to call his "Best Friends" first. He said he was diagnosed with cancer 4 years ago. He decided he wasn't going to tell anyone, he'd keep it a secret. He didn't want people the next four years always to say "poor Michael, how are you feeling?" with a pat on the shoulder. He wanted to continue to have his dreams. His barn was next on his agenda with it full of cars.

When he called he said I'm saying goodbye to you, Gil and Betty. I've got 3 - 4 weeks to live. What a shock to hear that. We had no idea what he was going through. Now we know why he couldn't always come up for our club events. He always said he had a conflict or something came up.

He was fighting his health problems. He called to say goodbye to us first and for me to put notice in "Spokes". Michael died November 4.

He graduated from Corning Community College. He served in the United States Navy. He worked as a New York State Inspector of Weights and Measures for 33 years. He was also a ham radio operator and a member of Elmira Heights American Legion Post 154 for 28 years. He enjoyed time on his sailboat, dancing, running and all activities involving cars. He joined the MG Car Club in 2004.

Michael is survived by his dearly beloved son Doug and his companion Denise, his ex-wife Judy Claprood, Granddaughter Kayla, sisters, several nieces, nephews and cousins.

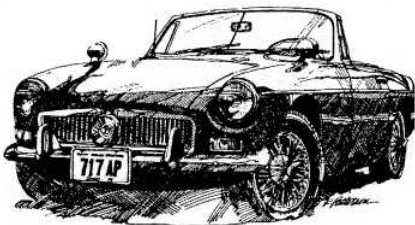

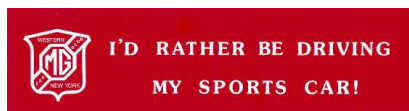
