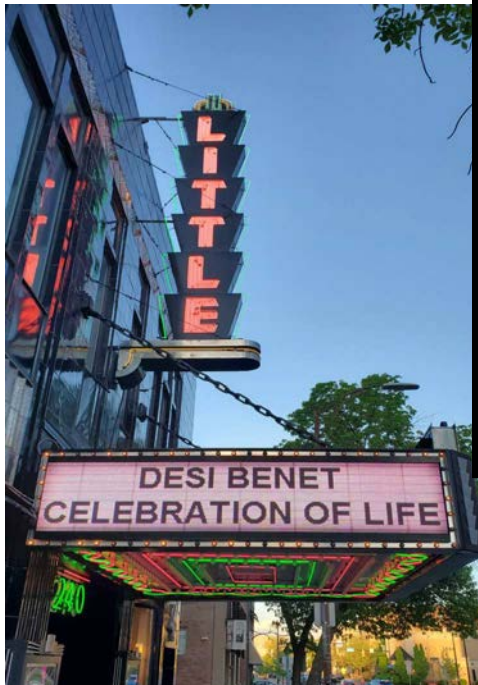

MGCC Minutes of the Meeting

The MGCC WNY meeting was called to order at 7:30 by Ted Hershey, with 35 members in attendance. The meeting minutes from the April meeting were motioned and seconded for acceptance.

One guest this month: Larry Willoughby, a guest of Bill Donlon and who is purchasing one of Bill's MGBs, joined us for the meeting. Anniversaries shared: Joe and Patti Bellizia 22 years; Mike and Sue Goodwin 42nd; John and Chris Baum 44th; Cheryl and Bill Baldwin 54th; Bob and Georgeann Able 58th. Congratulations to all!

The next topic was a Board report: Ted completed an analysis of our MGCC finances, combined with an analysis of membership renewals (less than expected/reported for 2018) and the outcome is that the club needs to reduce spending in 2019 in order to balance the books. Two actions are taking place:

- a) 'Pay-as-you-go' for all remaining events of 2019
- b) Convert *Spokes* distribution to e-mail starting in August – a choice form was distributed to ask members to choose: e-mail delivery (no additional cost above current dues); continued mail delivery (\$25 additional charge); or to vote to have the entire club pay the additional charge and continue mail distribution of all *Spokes*.

There was a thorough discussion – (I will try to briefly capture highlights here):

- Suggestions for the board to look across all incomes and costs – dues, event costs.
- Suggestion to ask membership for additional ideas, pay-as-you-go; also reminder of the need to provide financial update to the club 2x per year
- Suggestion to look at ways to broaden interest – core membership and peripheral membership
- Discussion and inputs regarding club history relating to how finances have been approached
- Suggestion to expand 'charter' to serve more marques (all British, or all European etc.) to serve more members. Follow-up question whether such a move would affect our MGCC affiliation.
- Discussion that the *Spokes* change will need to be addressed re: advertisers
- It was noted the intention is to keep the printed *Spokes* calendar
- Suggestion to ask other MGCC Centres. Dick Powers and Dan Suter will do this and report back
- Suggestion to expand the idea of Patrons as used for the show for additional donation income

Treasury – Leon provided a brief Treasury report and noted that the MCC endowed scholarship will be awarded again for 2019 (derived from MCC-managed funds that our MGCC had donated about ~8-12 years ago).

Activities: Recent and Upcoming events:

- Swing into Spring was a big success. Thanks to Dick Powers and Laurie Scribner for coordinating.
- Tune-Up Clinic May 4 was a success – thanks to Paul Osborne and Hollis Hames for coordinating.
- Hammondsport Mother's Day trip was enjoyable. Thanks to Jeff Kath is coordinating.
- Upcoming: May 18 – Watkins Glen IMMRC – Al Costich will speak as part of a presentation on Rallying. Bob Henderson and Al Isslehard will also be presenting.
- Apple Blossom Fly-In Pancake Breakfast May 19; John Schweim shared about the June 9 Bristol Cruise-In. Sonnenberg Gardens car show will be June 16. Fairport cruise nights now two separate locations on Tuesdays (competing....)
- All Watkins Glen rooms for Seneca Lodge for vintage race weekend are spoken for. See me if interested in starting a waiting list.

Membership – Paul Osborne reported that renewals are now about 125; grace period for renewals is complete so approx. 45 members were dropped after the grace period ended.

Regalia – Mike Robinson found a new source for hats – 2 styles. Mike is taking orders.

Spokes – June issue will be a 'full content' month - new submissions for June are due on May 23.

Librarian – Al Costich –no report; Website – Leon shared that the Car Show form is online. Cars and parts for sale section of the website has been merged with the MGCC Central NY.

2019 Car Show – Joe Bellizia gave an update on the car show planning. Show will be at the Rush Fire Department field on Sunday, July 21. Sign-up sheets are now available – please sign up, as additional volunteers are welcome and needed! Help with finding advertisers is still also needed. Corvair club has submitted (10) pre-registrations and will have a new class. The show is our major fundraiser, so please support it and also volunteer to help!

Old Business – none.
