




#### Add Your Name to the MGCC Endowed Scholarship Plaque






#### MG's Corner



#### The Great Race - 1908



In 2023, it may be hard to believe that in 1908, a car race would be run from New York to Paris, given that there wasn't a real highway system in the US or other countries. In Russia, they traveled next to the Trans-Siberian Railway to keep a sense of direction and get to major cities where gasoline may be available. No gas stations back then. The early part of the race did go through Victor, Pittsford and Rochester on Rt.5, but in other places, people had never seen a car.

The race was sponsored by the *New York Times* and a French paper, *Le Matin*. Six cars were entered. Three were from France and one each from Italy, Germany

and a 1907 Thomas Flyer, made in Buffalo, for the United States. Winning this race had tremendous political implications, so much so that the German team was made up of soldiers from the German army. There were also politics regarding the American team. Initially, the Thomas Company wasn't going to enter a car. No American car was entered, but a call from President Teddy Roosevelt to his friend Edwin Thomas, changed all that. So on the morning of February 12, 1908, six cars lined up in Times Square. 250,000 people were there for

the start, and one was *George* 

**Schuster**, who started out as the riding mechanic of the Thomas and by Chicago, he was also the driver. After 169 days, overcoming tremendous obstacles, George and the Thomas entered Paris and were declared the winner of the Grate Race.


The details of the race are far too many for this article. George's great-grandson, Jeff Mahl, has co-authored a book: *The Man and Car that Circled the Globe* that tells the story. This is a wonderful book

and is written from the perspective of George Schuster through the notes he kept in his journal during the race and from the many stories George told Jeff. The book is also loaded with many photos George took along the way after the NY Times photographer decided, in Alaska, that the race was much too rough for him!

Jeff Mahl also does a one-hour presentation of the race wherein he takes on the persona of his great

grandfather. I first heard this in 2008, along with Dick and Marlene Rzepkowski, at the 100th Anniversary celebration. This past Sunday, July 23, at the Buffalo Transportation

Museum, Bethel and I enjoyed an encore presentation by Jeff, but with the added touch of having it given from the actual 1907 Thomas Flyer that won the race! The winning Thomas Flyer, along with other Thomas cars, will be at the museum through August 6.


