

Meeting Minutes MGCC WNY Meeting November 21st, 2024

The November meeting of the MGCC Western NY Centre was held on a dark and rainy evening. Chairman George Heissenberger called the meeting to order at 7:33 PM. We had 39 members and no guests in attendance.

New Members and Guests:

New member John Eberhardt was in attendance again this month. John briefly noted that repairs on his 1967 Jaguar E-type are underway. Several birthdays and anniversaries were announced.

Meeting minutes from October were motioned and approved with no changes.

Treasurer and Membership Report: Treasurer Todd Black provided the Treasury report. Todd first noted this month marks the completion of two years in this role. He also updated that dues for 2025 are now due and can be accepted via PayPal, checks, or cash. Our balances remain good, and we have 134 members total. Todd updated that he was able to gain access for all members to the MGCC UK club magazine Safety Fast, as published in Spokes. George Heissenberger added a brief overview of club November balances in the period 2017-present which reflected a healthy, active club.

Activities Report –Dave Kray gave the Activities report:

Past Events:

 Thank-you tours were held to Beers of the World and McArdles. The Eagle Crest Winery thank-you tour was postponed until Spring.

Upcoming Events:

- The Holiday Party will be Dec 7 at Glendoveers in Penfield.
- Dave noted we are looking for events (and event coordinators) for 2025. Some events already in the planning stages include the Tune Up clinic in early May, and possible renewal of Valve Cover Races.
- Awards for the Motoring Challenge, which closed on Nov 2, will be announced at the Holiday Party.

Regalia Joe Bellizia gave the Regalia report. Joe briefly discussed new shirts, hats, the possibility of winter knit hats (embroidered) availability, and possible options for less expensive tumbler glasses.

Spokes – Don Welch discussed the Spokes update. Don thanked everyone for submitting articles , and asked club members to keep sending articles and photos. We are lining up MGCC/WNY MGA articles for the next few months. Deadline is one week from Friday following the meeting.

Watkins Glen: Ken Barlow is setting up 2025 Seneca Lodge reservation requests—please contact Ken with your requests. The normal schedule (SVRA and downtown festival after Labor Day) will resume for 2025.

Librarian: Paul Osborne briefly discussed old Safety Fast and Abingdon Classics magazines which are available.

MG Century: Bob Welch spoke about recently receiving this new history book about MGs from noted MG author David Knowles. Bob shared how much he liked this new book and how the book included some historical photos he had never seen before.

Website: Webmaster Leon Zak noted "It's there!" but went on to describe new behind-the-scenes hosting for the website, and that all is running well.

Car Show: Leon discussed our potential space limitations this past July at the NY Museum of Transportation, which was only alleviated by the fact that the Syracuse Nationals was held the same weekend. The museum has great interest in working with us going forward and has already started to clear additional space in the back fields. It was discussed and agreed that we need a map of the proposed additional space, and that our club needs to choose a date for the show. It was concluded this will be picked up by the new Board in January.

Old Business: George Heissenberger gave the third and final reading of the following statement as a revision to our MGCC Bylaws: "If there is no candidate interested in an elected position whose term is expiring, we will allow a one-year exemption to allow the current office holder to continue in their current position beyond the two-year limit as per current MGCC bylaws." Her first car was a Fiat 850 Spider and she has always preferred cool sporty cars. We even bought a 1963 Maserati Sebring together when we were dating (I didn't realize it had LUCAS Fuel injection- yikes!). Anyways, back to the MG- this MGA is really her car.

This 1958 1500 MGA roadster came from Columbus Ohio and was owned by a locally known boxer and his father. They had brought it to a shop and the costs of restoration were too overwhelming. So on to Craigslist it went to a new caretaker. Road trip with a local hauler and it became a WNY resident.

Body off, lots of sheet metal from the UK, and lots of welding (I could stick weld, but nothing beats a new MIG). Fortunately the engine was already upgraded to a 1600 and rebuilt. 




