Chairman's Corner

I'll summarize that feedback and we'll turn that into action to improve the processes and thus experience next year. Personally, I will focus on reducing chores and the time each volunteer has in parking and registration because they don't get to see the cars, to increase the fun for those who volunteer, your feedback could be different.

If you would rather call and have me record your feedback, I'm happy to take your call and listen to the constructive feedback you have to offer. There were paper forms at the last meeting, a few people submitted a hard copy, that's fine too.

The Friday after the car show, on August 14th a group of us drove to Gananoque Ontario Canada for MG 103 Fest, sponsored by the Toronto MG Car Club and the Ottawa MG Car Club. This was a very well run event, with something to do Friday, Saturday and Sunday, but with sufficient downtime to be able to socialize and relax. Arriving Friday, we spread out our snacks before dinner, and then about 40 pizzas were delivered for a party. We sat in the patio and parking lot of the hotel, stuffed with MGs, then stuffed with snacks and pizza. Saturday, we had a nice tour of around a hundred miles, from the village roughly North to a canal lock and historic location, then back South to a riverside restaurant for lunch. Sunday was the car show. Quite the weekend, it was somehow relaxing and refreshing. The trip home was uneventful, except for the border crossing. SVRA, Vintage Racing and the Grand Prix Festival are coming up fast, there was 1 free room at last check, so if you need a room, it's probably not too late to ask. We're looking forward to a fun-filled week. I'll arrive Wednesday and relax, Thursday help the racers get setup in the paddock and attend the marque specific car show and tour with Chris. Friday I think we have a second tour, then the festival. Saturday and Sunday are racing all day. If you've never been, you're really missing out. Even if you just go for Friday, park somewhere in the village and enjoy the sights and sounds of the cars, drive the old

street course, have some food and drinks, hang out with fellow club members at the Seneca Lodge. The racing at the track is some of the cheapest entertainment you can buy. Full weekend pass from Wednesday to Sunday is \$80, I think, and come and go as you please, walk/park wherever you like inside the track, spectate from any grandstand or patch of grass. It's truly a great opportunity to see some vintage wheel to wheel road racing and hang out with club members and their race cars.

The lovely auxiliary ladies would like more of a heads up next year re our stopping time in order to better plan for food amounts.

Discussion elicited to be had on potential rain day and/or alternative arrangements to fall back on if we do get rained out → further discussion to be had in the future.

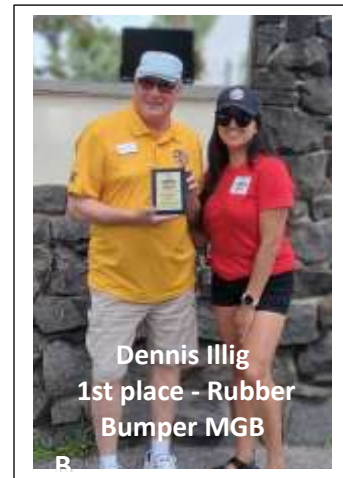

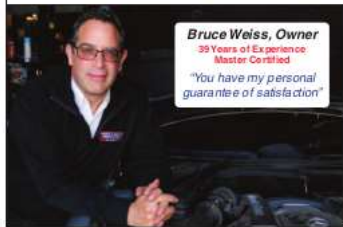

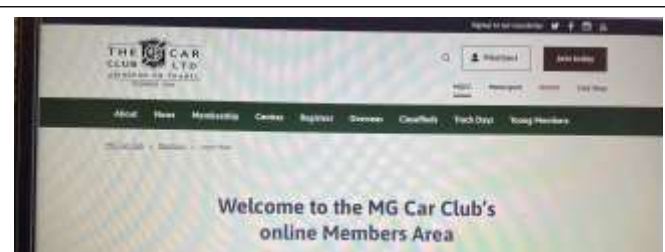
